# **Signing Authority**

### BACKGROUND

The efficient conduct of the charter school business is supported by the designation by the CAPE Charter Board of multiple signing authorities for school, banking and investment purposes.

## **POLICY STATEMENT**

1. The CAPE Charter Board Chair or the Vice-Chair or designate and/or the Principal or Superintendent are the signing authorities for CAPE School.

## DEFINITIONS

- 2. Efficient capable of producing desired results with little or no waste.
- 3. **Cross-referencing -** the listing of every file name and line number where a given named identifier occurs within the program's source tree.

## GUIDELINES

- 4. The signatures of the Chair of the CAPE Charter Board Chair is required on all bank-related documents, investment documents, contracts, or agreements.
- 5. The signatures of the Chair of the CAPE Charter Board or the Vice-Chair or designate and Principal or Superintendent are required on all cheques issued from the CAPE general account, and any other accounts that may be established as the need arises.
- 6. The Secretary-Treasurer's duties include but are not limited to the issuing of cheques, the preparation of documents, and the completion of forms as required by the CAPE Charter Board's commitments and obligations.
- 7. The Executive Assistant's duties include but are not limited to completion of all deposit sheets and bank deposits.
- 8. The Principal or Superintendent approves all purchases, and reviews and initials invoices after cross-referencing these with payment cheques.
- 9. The CAPE Charter Board Chair reviews, dates, and initials all bank statements and bank reconciliations.
