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Vice Principal Advisory Council

Students in grades 6-9 at CAPE have the opportunity to participate in the Vice Principal's Student Advisory Council. In this group, students are guided by Mrs. Edey, to work collectively to represent the interests of the student community within the school. In order to be a member of the council, the students show interest and there is follow up with the classroom teachers to ensure that the students are demonstrating positive work habits, collaborations and interactions with peers. Once the council is formed, students attend regularly scheduled meetings, approximately once each month, to discuss and come up with ideas that will provide opportunities for students to engage in fundraising, spirit days, and school events such as dances, movie and game nights.

With the re-introduction of a CAPE student council, the student voice is present in decision making and cohesive planning opportunities. Students feel their ideas are being heard and taken into consideration when school events and activities take place. Students are learning how to respectfully listen to others, share and express individual thoughts, in addition to feeling that they are part of a unified group that is providing positive opportunities for the school community.

Participation with the Advisory Council has allowed the students to take on leadership roles within activities demonstrating their skill sets and their eagerness to participate in the tasks required for events and activities. Students express their creativeness and willingness to assist others.
