My 23 year son is enrolled in an IT program at the college and my 16 year old son is in grade 11. The teachers molded and nurtured them to become responsible and respectful and kind human beings. However, I truly believe that in the time they had been at CAPE School, they healed enough so that they had the "education bug" in their souls. my 2 children were surprised at how positive graduating has impacted them. They told me they no longer consider themselves "drop-outs", "losers", "lower class". They feel it in their souls now that they have "post-secondary education" and have "a university BAA or College diploma:, they are winners, and they now have a pride in themselves.
